The Cruizin' for Crime Stoppers Motorcycle Ride draws increasing crowds annually from all over South Florida. The riders depart at 10:30am from the park and participate in a 100 mile ride through Palm Beach County escorted by Palm Beach and Broward Counties Sheriff's Motors Units. Riders return to the park around 1:00 pm for a live band, food trucks and raffle prizes. The event is open to the public.

Thank you for your interest in this year's event. Please read and complete the application to participate as an independent contractor for this year's event.

Registration fee is \$100. Applications are due by December 10, 2025.

1. Food Vendors are by invitation only so we may provide event attendees with a variety of foods without duplication. Space is limited.
2. Electricity is not available. Vendors must supply their own generator. Generators must be placed strategically to try and avoid noise and fumes interfering with attendees or other vendors.
3. Food Truck Vendors may offer fast food that is prepared within their truck. All food service operations must be conducted within the space provided. Only non-alcoholic beverages may be offered.
4. RAIN DATE IS FEBRUARY 15, 2026 – Palm Beach County Sheriff will determine if the weather conditions pose a risk to event participants. Postponement of the event will be determined 24 hours in advance of the event.
5. Event Organizer will review all applications and has the authority to approve or deny participation in this event.
6. Vendors must be present and open for business during event operational hours 12pm – 3:30 pm.
7. **Certificates of Insurance** reflecting auto insurance, workers comp (or exemption certificate), and general liability insurance- minimum coverage of \$1 million per occurrence and \$2 million aggregate are required. Additional insureds include:

8. Applicant shall take the proper safety and health precautions to protect the patrons, the amphitheater, the public, and the property of others at the event.
9. Vendor shall be responsible for all damages to persons and/or property that occur because of the vendor's negligence or misconduct.
10. Vendors are required to supply the equipment needed for setup, operations, and sales.
11. Vendors agree to comply with all applicable Federal, State, County, and City laws, regulations, and post proof of all necessary licenses in its booth.
12. Parking is conveniently located onsite & vendor-parking pass will be provided with parking details.
13. Vendors acknowledge that placement of tables, chairs, products, boxes, or frame sign, cannot extend further than 3 feet from their assigned vendor space. Vendors are liable for any injury or damages caused by signs.
14. Vendors agree to keep their space(s) attractive and clean it when the event ends. All litter, cardboard boxes, product debris, crates boxes, etc. must be removed at the close of the event.
15. All food trucks MUST DISPLAY a SERVE SAFE CERTIFICATION and must have one (2A:10BC) fire extinguisher present in the truck.
16. Vendors agree to allow the use of video and photography if taken by event organizers at the event for promotional purposes. Any photos taken by the organizers are the property of Crime Stoppers of PBC.
17. All food handlers must wear gloves.
18. Food Truck Vendor shall execute this agreement as an independent contractor and shall at all times have complete supervision, direction, and control over the services to fulfill requirements. Vendors must execute this agreement as an independent contractor, not as an employee of Crime Stoppers of Palm Beach County. Vendors will assume responsibility for appropriate payment of payroll taxes and charges under applicable federal and local state tax regulation as independent contractors.

Once the application has been submitted & approved, an admission package and set-up instructions will be emailed out to participating vendors at least two weeks prior to the event.
